APPETIZER *(choice of one)*

Quesadilla – Shrimp, beef or vegetarian.

Beef Flautas - Shredded beef barbacoa, corn tortilla, chile morita salsa, black bean puree, shredded lettuce, pico de gallo, guacamole, crema fresca

Combo Tostadas – A sampling of crab, chicken and tuna tostadas.

Tortilla Soup – Shredded chicken, panela cheese, avocado, onion, cilantro, chile guajillo-tomato broth, crispy tortilla strips, crema fresca.

ENTREE *(choice of one)*

Combo Ceviches – Tuna, shrimp and mahi mahi ceviche served on a platter.

Combo #1 – Pork carnitas, chicken tamal and cheese enchilada. Served with refried black beans and rice.

Combo #2 – Chicken tamal, shaved taco and beef enchilada. Served with refried black beans and rice.

Combo Tacos – Pollo, carne and carnitas taco. Served with refried black beans and rice.

Chicken Enchiladas Divorciadas – Shredded chicken, roasted tomato-guajillo sauce, tomatillo cream sauce. Served with refried black beans and rice.

DESSERT *(choice of one)*

Tres Leches – Traditional Mexican three-milk cake, passion fruit reduction.

Banana Empanadas – Cajeta Sauce, coconut sorbet.

Morenita Chocolate Brownie – Chocolate brownie, cinnamon ice cream, cajeta sauce, chocolate sauce.

Las Vegas Restaurant Week began in 2007 as a way to give locals and tourists the opportunity to help out by dining out. The weeklong celebration of fine dining includes more than 80 participating restaurants, from popular mid-level eateries to the city's premier and celebrity-chef restaurants, all offering pre-fixe meals at special prices. Proceeds from Restaurant Week benefit Three Square Food Bank, established to end hunger in Southern Nevada.
